As the national Grant Decision has been already issued by the minister of Education earlier in May, CEITEC has become the **first large project** from the Operational Programme Research and Development for Innovations **to be approved on all levels**.



CEITEC has successfully concluded several years of preparations and is starting its implementation phase. It is therefore the most suitable occasion **to express our sincere gratitude to all those that helped our project** during the very demanding period. I also hope that CEITEC will enjoy your support in the years to come as we are all very much looking forward to our continuous cooperation.

Naturally, we are aware of the fact that the approval was not a goal in itself. It makes it possible however to realize the real reason for all the work that has been done – building in Brno an internationally recognized centre of excellence. • •

CEITEC opens new positions

The Ministry of Education opened the selection process for a new CEITEC Executive Director and Scientific Director, who are to take charge of the management of the centre at the beginning of 2012. They will be reputable international experts who will fulfil the criteria of relevant experience in managing a research centre and appropriate scientific practice.

Sixteen top quality international researchers have been already hired for key leading positions, predominantly from Europe and the US. New positions will be opening within a few weeks. Currently we are filling five vacancies for Research Groups leaders with international professionals, who will be young international specialists with excellent reputations and relevant experience. ••



CEITEC presents itself abroad


