Brno

- The capital of South Moravian Region and the second largest city in the Czech Republic with a population of almost 400,000 people,
- Strategic geographic position within Central Europe with good transport accessibility,
- Modern, dynamic and fast growing centre of industry, trade, science, research and innovation with business incubators and centres of excellence in science,
- A city of universities with more than 86,000 students (one third in science & technology fields) at five public universities,
- More than 10,000 researchers; 2,200 IF publications/year; 600+ PhD graduates/year,
- 500 mil. EUR of R&D investment per year (nearly 3 bil. EUR of R&D investment in period 2002 2012), more than 350 companies with in-house R&D,
- City of Gregor Mendel, the founder of genetics; the prestigious Mendel Lectures series takes place in Brno since 2003 (lectures of the world's top scientists, including Nobel Prize winners),

Masaryk University (MU)

- The second largest university in the Czech Republic,
- · Respected research university and one of the fastest growing higher education institutions in the Czech Republic,
- Consisting of 9 faculties with over 200 departments, institutes and medical clinics, covering a wide range of research areas in both the humanities and the natural sciences,
- A total of 47,500 students, including bachelors, masters and more than 3.000 PhD students currently enrolled at MU,
- One of the leading research organizations in the Czech Republic in the natural sciences and biomedicine,
- Publishing a total of about a thousand original research papers registered in WoS each year; more than a third in collaboration with scientists from abroad e.g. collaborators from the USA (9.5% of all papers published), Germany (9.5%), the UK (5.8%), and France (5.4%),
- 7 out of 14 Czech EMBO Installation Grants awarded to MU as a demonstration of the institution where the scientists return after their successful career abroad,
